Helios Cinema is in the Słoneczne estate, within the Outlet Park Szczecin shopping center, at Andrzeja Struga. There are approximately 750 parking spaces nearby. Normal lines 66, 71, 73, 77 and express lines B, D, G stop in the vicinity of the cinema (Andrzeja Struga stop).

In the Outlet Park shopping centre, there is one of the two cinemas in Szczecin belonging to the Helios brand. There are seven screens in the cinema, where the latest cinema screenings are shown. The selected repertoire is reproduced using Dolby 3D Digital Cinema technology. Each room is air-conditioned and equipped with excellent sound equipment, as well as well-known Harkness cinema projectors. Armchairs were made by Figueras. The cinema can seat 1,403 viewers at the same time. Helios hosts pre-premiere screenings with the participation of the creators. Moreover, film marathons, animations for children and thematic screenings for organized groups are organized there. The cinema is open to cooperation
