

The Culture and Sports Centre of Polanowo



The Culture and Sports Centre of Polanowo is situated between Polna and Koszalińska Streets. To reach the centre head from the roundabout in the town centre towards Koszalin following provincial road no. 206 and then take the second street on the left, i.e. Polna Street. The centre is situated on the right side of the street.

The Culture and Sports Centre of Polanowo is a commune unit whose aim is to promote culture among the inhabitants of the commune, and educate children and youths.

The centre comprises eleven village clubs that operate in the commune. They were created with the youngest inhabitants in mind. During classes at the centre they do homework with the help of a caretaker, read obligatory books and participate in arts and sports classes.

The centre in Polanowo offers a number of classes for both children and adults: guitar lessons, theatre classes, vocal classes, dance classes and handicraft

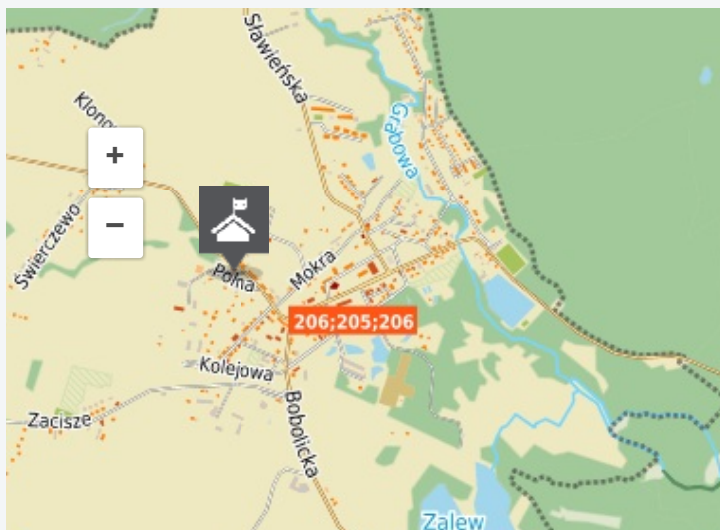

The Culture and Sports Centre of Polanowo is the main organizer of most cultural events in the commune, including open-air events, e.g. fishing competitions, county harvest festivals, holiday markets, recitation competitions, concerts. One of the most popular events is Międzynarodowy Zlot Motocykli [the International Motorcycle Rally]. The aim of the events is the presentation of skills acquired during classes at the centre, social integration of the inhabitants of the region and the promotion of the commune among visitors.
