

# Seaside Miniatures and Trains Park



The Seaside Miniatures and Trains Park in Dziwnów (Kamień County) is situated at Dziwna Street. Head for Międzyzdroje and turn left just past the bascule bridge. The park lies 100 m farther, on the right side of the street.

The Seaside Miniatures and Trains Park is an interesting spot on the map of Dziwnów. In the picturesque park there are miniatures of Polish lighthouses in a 1:10 scale, and replicas of locomotives, steam locomotives and train cars. To the delight of the youngest visitors the locomotives run on the tracks and produce clouds of fumes.

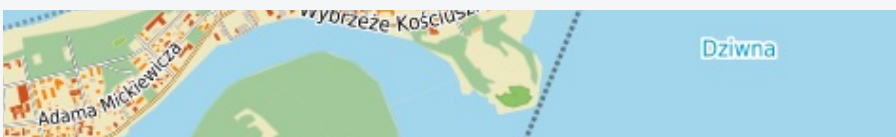
