

# The Culture Centre of the Town and Commune of Wolin

Wolin



The Centre offers an alternative to free afternoons by organizing youth clubs. There is an art club, the Ballroom Dance Club, a sculpting school, musical instrument playing workshops, vocal ensembles in the Amateur Creator's Club, the "Piwnica" Gallery, and the "SPRINTER" sports club operating Gymnasium in Wolin. Special activities are organized during a winter break. The Centre organizes art, recitation, and spelling contests for children and youth from the region. The Wolin Drum Orchestra is active within the Centre. There are culinary workshops organized; also an exhibition activity is well developed.

The centre is also an organizer and co-organizer of a number of festivals and cyclic events, such as "Saxmania 2015" International Festival, or Wolin Monodrama Spring. Other cyclic events are "Karawana Kultury" festival, Polish-German Otto Harvest Festival and the Dni Wolina festival. One of the largest events

The major seat of the centre is Wolin; it also supervises, however, the Country Community Centres in Wisetka, Dargobądz, and Troszyn.


