The City Hall in Szczecin is in a restored building from the beginning of the 20th century, located at Armii Krajowej Square. Access from Plac Grunwaldzki by bus line 70. From the north-west side it borders with Jasne Błonia.

The branch of the Szczecin City Hall in Prawobrzeże is located at 39-40 Rydla Street.

The office operates on the basis of the following structure: Office of the Mayor of the City, City Council Office, Strategy Office, Investor and Business Service Department, Internal Control and Audit Department, Organizational Department, Social and Marketing Communication Office, Customer Service Office, Civil Registry Office, Public Procurement Office, Education Department, Culture Department, Sport Department, Social Affairs Department, Office of NGOs, Municipal Investments Department, Town Planning and Construction Administration Department, Office of the City Surveyor, Department of Real Estate Management, Municipal Economy and Environmental Protection Department, City Finance Management Department, Accounting Department, Taxes and Local Fees Department, Administrative Execution Department, Crisis Management and Civil Protection Department, IT Department, Office Service, Ownership Supervision Office, Legal Office, Office for the Protection of Classified Information, Office of the Municipal Consumer Ombudsman, Office of the Municipal Monument Conservator. 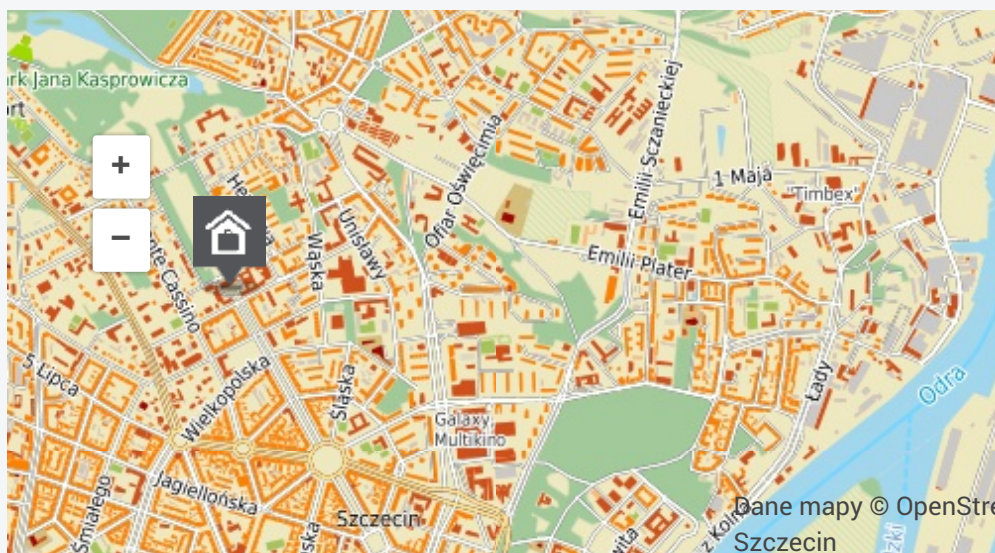
