

The Polanów Culture and Sports Centre Tourist Information

The Polanów Culture and Sports Centre Tourist Information is located between Polna and Koszalińska Streets. In order to reach the Centre, one has to turn into the second street on the left (Polna Street), going from a roundabout in the town centre towards Koszalin along regional road no 206. The building is situated on the right side of the street.

The Tourist Information Point is located in the Polanów Culture and Sports Centre.

It is a place established to meet the needs both of people visiting the region and of its inhabitants. The Tourist Information provides free-of-charge consultations concerning regional tourist attractions, such as sights, overlooks, nature reserves, etc. Tourists preferring active forms of rest can use the database gathering information on hiking, biking, and horseback riding routes, as well as on opportunities for fishing.

Tourists can also find out details about places connected with recreation (bathing beaches, shooting ranges), places of culture (libraries, community centres, museums, theatres), and sports and culture events taking place in the region.

Tourist Information Point also provides all information on accommodation and catering.

In the Information Point, it is possible to purchase maps and guidebooks, as well as to receive free publications.

Moreover, in front of the entrance to a public library in Polanów at 7 Wolności, there is an interactive kiosk serving the function of a twenty-four-hour tourist information. Also, in the reading room of the library, there is an additional tourist information point.

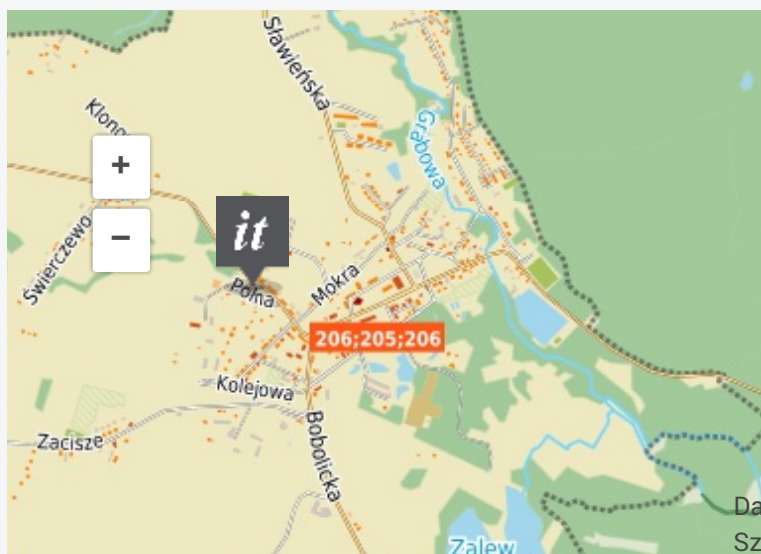
